

# 2024/2025 Regular Membership Summary

#### Introduction

Located in the foothills above the Stanford University campus, the Stanford Golf Course is consistently rated one of the finest courses in the world. The course is open to Stanford constituents (students, faculty/staff, and alumni) and members and their guests. Throughout the years, Stanford has hosted many intercollegiate and non-collegiate events, including U.S. Open Qualifying, Women's NCAA Championships, NCAA Regionals, Pac-12 Championships and the USGA Junior Amateur Qualifying.

One of approximately 30 college courses in the country, Stanford Golf Course opened in 1930 and was designed by famed architects George C. Thomas and Billy Bell Jr. The firm of Robert Trent Jones II completed minor remodeling work during the 80s and 90s. The firm of John Harbottle III remodeled greens and bunkers in 1994. In 2004, the firm of Knott Brooks Linn completed a redesign of the third and fourth holes. In 2018, all bunkers were rebuilt and several holes were modified.

#### Membership Process

Prospective members must go through the following process to apply for membership:

- Prospective member must fill out the Stanford Golf Course Membership Application. Completed applications should be sent to <a href="mailto:golfmembership@stanford.edu">golfmembership@stanford.edu</a>
- Prospective member must solicit two references\*
  - Referring members must be current members.
  - Referring members cannot be family of prospective member.
- Upon validation of the application, prospective member will receive notification and be added to the wait list.
- The Membership Committee will meet every six months to review the wait list and determine who, if anyone, should be offered membership. Criteria that will be considered in the decision include:
  - Timing of application (i.e., position on the wait list)
  - o Alumni status alumni will generally be given priority over non-alumni
  - Family who are current or past members
  - o Historical engagement with Stanford and Stanford Athletics
  - Strength of application and references
- The General Manager will send a letter to prospective members being offered membership. The new member will have 30 days to submit their initiation fee and prorated first year dues.

\* No references needed for prospective Alumni members.

## Member Benefits

Members of the golf course have access to several benefits that are not available to other constituents (benefits marked with a \* are only available to Active members). These include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Online tee times\* ability to make tee time reservations online (13 days in advance).
- Free range balls\* your membership entitles you to free range balls at the Golf Learning Center. Please note that these balls are for member use only and should not be shared with friends or other patrons of the Learning Center.
- Member Practice Area\* Weekends only.
- Free push carts\* your membership entitles you to a complimentary pull cart.
- Pro shop discount your membership entitles you to the following discounts at both the Pro Shop and Golf Learning Center:
  - o 20% off all soft goods
  - 10% off all hard goods (balls and clubs)
- Advance group reservations you can make one advance group reservation each year (up to 4 foursomes).
- Opportunity to purchase discounted guest passes every fiscal year.
- Unaccompanied Guest members are allowed to make tee times for unaccompanied guests to play the course without being in attendance.
